CA Short Line Improvement Program

The application period for project funding under the \$7.2 million California short line railroad grant program established by SB 87 in 2019 ("Short Line Railroad Improvement Program"), is now open. The primary objective of the Short Line Railroad Improvement Program is to fund infrastructure improvement projects designed to enable Class III/short-line railroads to improve freight mobility, efficiency, reliability, sustainability, safety,



and load capacity. Grant qualification criteria and additional information may be accessed via the California Transportation Commission (CTC) link below. California short lines interested in applying must partner with either Caltrans or a Regional Transportation Planning Agency in order to apply. Caltrans will be posting application materials for railroads interested in partnering with Caltrans by late August and anticipates a mid-October deadline for completed applications. The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (Bay Area) has also begun outreach to railroads in its area of responsibility. CSLRA strongly encourages CA short lines to take advantage of this unique funding opportunity.

2020 California Freight Mobility Plan Released

The newest edition of the California Freight Mobility Plan (CFMP) was published on July 20. This important state-wide planning document is produced every five years and is worthwhile reading for everyone in the California short line community. Quoting Caltrans: "In collaboration with various State, regional and local partners, public and private sectors, and the members of the California Freight Advisory Committee (CFAC), Caltrans developed the California Freight Mobility Plan 2020 to provide a long-term vision for California's freight future. The CFMP is a comprehensive plan that governs the immediate and long-range planning activities and capital investments by the state with respect to freight movement. This multimodal freight transportation system facilitates the reliable and efficient movement of goods while ensuring a prosperous economy, social equity, and human and environmental health. The CFMP also complies with California State Government Code Section 13978.8(b) (1) (Assembly Bill 14, Lowenthal) and the freight provisions of the federal Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act (FAST Act) which requires each state that receives funding under the National Highway Freight Program to develop a State Freight Plan." Our Survey Said: Short Line Input Needed

A planner's work is never done. Although a new CFMP was just released (see above), work is underway on the next California State Rail Plan, a companion document to the CFMP. Caltrans seeks to expand coverage of short line railroads in the next version of this plan, and needs your input for a "Short Line Rail Improvement Plan," a strategy document that will feed into the next State Rail Plan to "advance the short line rail industry in California to encourage track upgrades, industrial rail access improvements, advanced technologies, clean alternative energy solutions, improving efficiencies, and to promote a cost-effective shift from truck to rail." Industry outreach for this project is being conducted by professional services provider Jacobs on behalf of Caltrans. CSLRA will be assisting with the outreach. If you are asked to participate (or want to volunteer), please contribute your knowledge and ideas to this important effort.
